

## **Tenure Track Faculty Positions in Biomaterials and Tissue Engineering**

The Department of Biomedical Engineering at Case Western Reserve University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the associate or full professor level. Candidates should have a research emphasis in Biomaterials and Tissue Engineering; those with interests in **targeted therapeutics and/or nanotechnological approaches with cancer applications** are particularly encouraged to apply. An endowed chair is associated with our position for candidates who focus on research related to cancer. The Biomaterials & Tissue Engineering group within our department currently has 7 full time faculty and >15 associated faculty. In addition, the campus is close to some of the nation's major clinical research centers including: the Cleveland Clinic, University Hospitals of Cleveland, the Case Comprehensive Cancer Center, Louis Stokes VA Medical Center and MetroHealth Medical Center. Candidates should make strong connections with other researchers in the area.
